SOCIETY FISHERIES.

NEWDIGATE Nr DORKING.

A locked fishery, with fine hard standing car parking and gentle downhill easy access for disabled anglers with wheelchairs.



Two lovely lakes each about an acre in size, the top lake has 20 carefully placed permanent swims with high edges and solid bases some allowing fishing to islands, one specially designed for disabled anglers with another in development. The bottom lake totally untouched with natural banks and good bank side cover. Both nestling in beautiful wooded surroundings, a very natural well established fishery .

Well stocked with small common and mirror carp up to low doubles, roach ,rudd, tench and crucians. One or two chub and barbel, with some small catfish.

Further fish introductions anticipated in 2008.

A perfect pleasure fishing venue with bags up to 45lbs coming to simple presentation. Regular club matches

run on the lakes. Ideal for juniors and anglers with developing skills and people who really appreciate the peace and quite of their surroundings..

OTHER FISHERIES. 2 Lakes in Chertsey with carp up to high doubles and a good head of other mixed fish.



In addition to our four lakes we also have three sections of river. The **River Mole** at Cobham, from which a 14.1/2lb barbell and a 28lb pike has been caught. Perch over two pounds and chub up to four pounds have been in recent bags. A stretch of the **River Colne** over at Stanwell was taken on at the beginning of the year, as yet an unknown quantity, but it's typical Colne and will no doubt have a good head of barbel and chub. Finally, a small stretch of the **River Wey** at Weybridge holds chub, roach and dace and the occasional big chub to the unprepared. We are also members of the **Basingstoke Canal Anglers Association**, which gives our members access to 32 miles of the canal from Byfleet where it joins the Wey Navigation to Odiham in Hampshire! There really is some superb fishing to be had quite close to home, with double figure carp to be caught in many sections.

MATCHES.

The club has regular matches on most Sundays in the Summer, visiting other fisheries like Willingshurst, MBK lakes, Frog Island and Charlie Frost's many and diverse lakes over at Newdigate. Trips also arranged for the Kennet at Padworth and on the Basingstoke Canal. Everyone is welcome, they are not serious affairs, just a day out really with a bunch of club members to good fisheries.
